He started as a Planner with the Official Plans Section of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and moved to the Subdivisions Section as a Senior Planner. Mr. Weston held the position of Assistant Manager in the Subdivisions Branch of the Ministry of Treasury and Economics. He also held the position of Manager of the Ontario Housing Action Program at the Ministry of Housing.

From 1974 to 1981, Mr. Weston was a partner in D.M. Consultants Limited where he acted as a Development Manager. Mr. Weston was a key contributor in the development of the Thornhill Community during which time he served as a member of the Developer's Escrow Trust Committee and was chair of the Developer's Committee on the Soft Service Levy.

Mr. Weston established a planning consulting practice in 1981. He is responsible for client representation before approval agencies, municipalities, administrative tribunals and the courts. Mr. Weston has extensive experience as an expert witness appearing before the Ontario Municipal Board, the Land Compensation Board, the Parkway Belt West Hearing Board, and the Supreme Court of Ontario on matters of Judicial Review, the Federal Court of Canada and the Legislative Committee of Cabinet. In addition, he is responsible for providing technical management on specific projects.
