Ms. Brown was also trained and worked as a cartographer with the Directorate of Overseas Survey producing five-coloured small scale mapping for developing countries such as Kenya and Zambia.

Ms. Brown is responsible for the supervision and work schedule of the design department, working closely with the planners, clients and other consultants. In addition to her supervisory role, she designs and prepares Development Concepts, Draft Plans of Subdivision, Site Plans, Secondary Plans, Severance Plans and full colour graphics used as exhibits for Ontario Municipal Board Hearings and Public Meetings, as well as graphics for inclusion in reports.
